## **Mission and Program Services**

Dogs On Death Row is an IRS-recognized tax-exempt charitable organization. Our mission is to rescue dogs at animal shelters that are about to be euthanized because their allotted time for adoption has expired. These dogs face imminent execution if they do not get interim financial sponsors or foster parents or receive medical treatment required to become adoptable. Gaining this extra time, our goal is to then find permanent homes for each animal.

## **The Year In Review**

- Saved 1033 dogs with medical issues from Death Row
- Provided grants to cover spay/neuter cost to over 2000 dogs
- Sponsored sixteen dogs at an animal sanctuary
- Provided international grants for dog rescue to Romania, Greece and Thailand
